

Message from Worshipful Master - Bill Enloe P. M.

My Brothers,

The trestle board topic for this month is the spring cleaning and activities to refresh the Lodge.

As far as spring cleaning, I will, more or less, discuss the figurative cleaning of the Lodge by stating we really need to have members of the Lodge take on ritual parts to keep our Lodge going. The problem with a recycle of Past-Masters is that we do not receive new leadership within the Lodge.

In order to keep the Lodge in good standing with Grand Lodge, we must perform each degree every year and each pedestal officer must be certified to be elected to their station. In other words, there is a strong ritual component to maintaining active status for the Lodge. When we recycle the same members year after year, we run the risk those members losing interest with

maintaining these certifications. It is then that the Lodge is at risk of no longer remaining a Lodge in the Grand Lodge of Arizona.

So, to spring clean we need to have new participants take an active part in performing ritual. We need members to want to be in the South, West, and East and want to keep this Lodge alive. This cannot happen with just a few members, but rather a much larger pool of members.

It is my responsibility, as part of that figurative spring cleaning, to prepare you to begin your ritualistic journey. The parts are repetitive, so that should assist with learning the parts, but they also contain a deeper symbolism of our Masonic teachings. So, you will learn more about the fraternity and our rich history by attempt-
