


On the Level... Senior Warden, Gerry Massey PM

The York Rite in Arizona By William Enloe, PM

The York Rite is an extension of the Blue Lodge degrees with an additional 10 degrees to continue your search for Masonic knowledge. There are three bodies that are contained in the York Rite, the Chapter, Council, and Commandery. They must be achieved successively, but your progress is your journey.

In the Chapter you have the Mark Master, Past Master, Most Excellent Master, and Royal Arch degrees. If you elect to continue to the Council, you will receive the Royal Master, Select Master and Super Excellent Master degrees. Lastly, if you wish to continue to the Commandery, you can attain the Illustrious Order of the Red Cross, Order of Malta, and Order of the Temple and become a Knight Templar.

There are several constituent bodies around the Valley that meet on different nights. So, like many Masonic Bodies, reach out and someone will provide you with more information.

Phoenix meets on the 2nd Monday, Chandler the 3rd Wednesday, Sun City the 3rd Friday, Scottsdale the 1st Tuesday, and Mesa 2nd Wednesday just to name the bodies that are local.

So, whether your Masonic journey started decades before or recently, there is always more to learn.
